The Colton City council met for the monthly meeting on Monday, November 21st, 2022, at Colton City Hall. Sheriff's Report – Total Patrol hours performed for October were sixty-nine hours and seven minutes.

Items to be addressed by Council -

1st Reading of Ordinance #3 Rezoning of Geraets addition was read through.

Discussion was had about Resolution #8 2022 Water Rate. A motion was made by Nesheim to approve Resolution #8 2022 Water Rate Resolution and was seconded by Lyon. The motion passed with present all members aye.

RESOLUTION __#8-2022__

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 4-2021 PERTAINING TO THE RATES CHARGED FOR WATER AND SEWER USAGE FOR THE CITY OF COLTON.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLTON:

Section 1: The following rates are hereby established for the water consumers and sewer users connected to the municipal water and sewer systems of the City.

All water consumption shall be billed for the actual gallons used. The base rate of \$15.38 fVALLEY CENTERAL COOPor the first 999 gallons used and \$3.18 per 1000 gallons of water consumption or fraction thereof.

All sewer usage shall be billed at a rate of \$8.00 for the first 999 gallons of water consumption and \$3.50 per 1000 gallons of water consumption or fraction thereof.

In addition to the other system charges, the City of Colton hereby establishes a monthly surcharge of \$5.00 payable be each sewage usage customer who receives or benefits from the services of the project financed by the City of Colton Sanitary Sewer Improvements – Phase IV Revenue Bond. Said surcharge shall be effective as of July 1, 2022.

The foregoing rates shall apply to locations within the City limits for water consumption and sewer usage for one (1) month period for single-family and commercial usages.

For water provided to locations outside the city limits, the residents or dwelling users shall pay the water charge for gallons consumed plus \$21.00 for the SRF loans.

Section 2:

All payments received shall be applied in the following order:

- 1. Late Fees (if applicable) or Misc. Fees
- 2. Rubble Site Maintenance Fee
- 3. SRF Loans
- 4. CW Loan
- 5. Sewer Charges
- 6. Water Charges

The foregoing resolution was introduced by Nesheim who moved for its passage and adoption; council member Lyon seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with 5 voting aye and 0 voting nay.

Whereupon Mayor Bunde declared the resolution passed and adopted and instructed the Municipal Finance Officer to publish this resolution in the official newspaper of the City and to comply with all applicable notice requirements of the law.

Adopted this 21st day of November, 2022.

Nesheim made a motion to enter executive session at 5:04 p m and seconded by Foster.

Foster made a motion to leave executive session and seconded by Amundson. Executive session was left at 8:23 pm.

Amundson moves to adjourn and was seconded by Nesheim. The meeting was then Adjourned at 8:23 pm.
