

Colton City Council Meeting February 11, 2019

The Colton City Council met in regular session on Monday February 11, 2019 at Colton City Hall. Mayor Lehman called the meeting to order at 7:30 with the following members present for roll call: Jeff Pedersen, Koopman and Bunde. Madison was present for city personnel. Swartwout was absent with cause. Jensen joined the meeting at 7:42pm by telephone.

A motion was made by Bunde and seconded by Koopman to approve the minutes for both the regular meeting held on January 14, 2019 and the special meeting held on January 22, 2019. A roll call vote was taken, motion passed with all members voting aye.

Department Reports:

Fire Department – NA

Park and Recreation – Members of the Tri Valley Baseball Association spoke to the council regarding the upcoming baseball season. The first TVHS home game is scheduled for April 11th weather permitting.
