Minnehaha County Begins Work to Expand Radio Coverage for Local First Responders

The Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office is spearheading a county wide project that will expand radio communication coverage for local first responders. According to Captain Joe Bosman with the Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office, "This project will greatly benefit every fire department, ambulance service, and law enforcement agency who serve the citizens of Minnehaha County."

Currently, first responders in rural Minnehaha County utilize two radio communication towers to perform their duties. One tower is located by Wall Lake, and the other northeast of Baltic. "Having only two towers, spaced far apart from each other, left large areas with out adequate radio coverage particularly in our northwest and eastern regions of the county. Recognizing this deficiency, we wanted to increase our radio coverage in those areas to provide better protection for our first responders and a higher level of service for the public." Captain Bosman added.

Starting in late 2022, Minnehaha County approved their Sheriff's Office to sign a contract with Motorola Solutions to expand their radio communications network by adding 5 additional sites. The locations selected include:

- Tower site north of Humboldt
- Tower site northeast of Hartford
- Colton water tower
- Tower site west of Baltic
- Garretson water tank

Each site will have a small concrete structure constructed at the base of the tower to house the electrical radio components necessary to operate the system. There will also be new communications towers erected at the Hartford, West Baltic, and Garretson locations.

Construction at the various tower sites has already begun with a project completion anticipated late this summer. The Minnehaha County Board of Commissioners has approved funding for this project by using \$3.75 million dollars from their American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. Additional partners in this project include South Dakota State Radio, Metro Communications, City of Garretson, and City of



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Colton. Captain Bosman added, "We are very grateful and excited to work with the communities of Colton and Garretson during this project. Their partnership with Minnehaha County to use their available locations for our communication equipment is a perfect fit to fill the coverage gaps in those areas. This expansion is truly a benefit for all parties involved."

WATER TANK OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT

This Occupancy Agreement ("Agreement") made and entered as of the Effective Date, as defined below, by and between the City of Colton ("Landlord"), of 309 E 4th St., Colton, SD 57018, and Minnehaha County, of 415 N. Dakota Ave., Sioux Falls, SD 57104 ("Tenant").

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein and intending to be legally bound hereby, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. <u>THE PREMISES</u>. Subject to the following terms and conditions and for the mutual benefit of the parties, Landlord grants to Tenant a nonexclusive space atop an Elevated Water Storage Tank as depicted on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, ("Occupied Space") which is located on certain real property in Minnehaha County, South Dakota, as described in Exhibit "B", attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, ("Premises") for Tenant's Use.
- 2. <u>TENANT'S USE</u>. In accordance with this Agreement, Tenant shall have the right to construct, install, maintain, improve, operate, repair and replace Communications Facility upon the Occupied Space. The term Communications Facility shall mean communications equipment, antennas, related facilities and equipment ("Facilities") upon the Occupied Space for the purpose of transmission and reception of communications signals.

3. TERM.

- a. <u>Initial Term</u>. The initial term of this Agreement shall be for a period of ten (10) years beginning on the Effective Date, unless extended or sooner terminated in accordance with this Agreement.
- b. Renewal Term. Provided Tenant has not failed or refused to perform any of Landlord's covenants, duties, agreements or obligations under this Agreement or is otherwise in default, Tenant shall have the right to extend this Agreement for three (3) additional terms of ten (10) years each on the same terms and conditions as set forth in this Agreement. Unless Tenant notifies Landlord of its election not to exercise any renewal term at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the initial term or the current renewal term, each renewal term shall automatically be exercised without notice or other action of any kind by Tenant.
- 4. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Agreement shall be effective as of the date of execution by both Parties ("Effective Date").
- 5. <u>RENTAL</u>. LESSOR, pursuant to SDCL Chapter 6-5 and in recognition of the benefit the City of Colton will receive with the placement of LESSEE's Communications Facilities on the Premises, LESSOR will provide the Premises to LESSEE without rent or additional charge, except as expressly set forth herein.

6. IMPROVEMENTS.

a. Tenant shall, in Tenant's discretion, design and construct the Communications

Facility in any manner Tenant deems appropriate limited to the proposed scope of the easement and restrictions herein. Tenant shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations in the design and construction of the Communication Facility. The Communications Facility shall remain the exclusive property of Tenant. Tenant shall remove the Communications Facility or any portion thereof, including footings to a depth of twenty-four (24) inches below grade, following the expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement and shall restore the lands, disturbed by Tenant's operations, to as near its original condition as is reasonably possible, reasonable wear and tear excepted within six (6) months of the conclusion of the Leasehold set forth herein. Said restoration shall be done in a timely and fashionable manner by Tenant, weather and soil conditions permitting, and Tenant shall pay rent at the then existing monthly rate on a month to month basis until such time as the removal of the Communication Facility is completed.

- b. The Communications Facility shall be at Tenant's expense and installation shall be at the discretion and option of Tenant. Tenant shall have the right to replace, repair, add or otherwise modify its Communications Facility and any portion thereof and the frequencies over which the communications equipment operates, whether or not any portion of the Communications Facility is listed on any exhibit.
- c. Before installation, Tenant must provide drawings and specifications detailing the installation of the equipment, cable runs, supports, penetrations, fastening methods, foundations, panels, electrical power connections, grounding, and all other required details for a complete installation shall be submitted for review and approval by Landlord. Landlord may require a structural analysis be performed, at Tenant' expense. A drawing depicting the final appearance of the tank shall also be included. A Licensed Electrical Contractor shall submit all drawings and specifications. Re-submittal of drawings and specifications detailing requested changes shall be required prior to final approval.
- d. Any damage to the existing tank interior or exterior coating systems shall be repaired with new equivalent coating systems during Tenant' equipment installation work. Coating repairs shall be approved by Landlord.
- e. During operation, Tenant shall operate its Communication Facility so that the presence and/or operation of Tenant's equipment will have minimal impact on the Occupied Space including the Tank's periodic maintenance work (i.e., Tank inspections, painting, etc.). Landlord reserves the right to perform structural or cosmetic maintenance on the Tank. As such, Tenant understand that it may need to take its antennas out of service, at its own expense, for a period of time during such events. Further, in the event the Landlord overcoats, repaints, undertakes structural repair, or replaces the Tank, the Landlord may require Tenant to remove some or all of Tenant' equipment or Landlord may require the Tenant to remove some or all of Tenant' equipment from the Tank for the duration of the project. Any securing, rearrangement, or removal of equipment will be

undertaken by Tenant at Tenant' expense. Tenant will be responsible for and agrees to provide adequate measures to cover and otherwise protect its personal property and equipment from paint and debris fallout or damage which may occur during any painting, restoration, repair, maintenance, or reconstruction. Landlord shall give Tenant at least sixty (60) days' prior written notice of the intended work, unless work is necessary for emergency reasons in which case Landlord will provide reasonable notice considering the circumstances, which may consist of notice by email or telephone. An "emergency" is a situation that constitutes an immediate threat to the health or safety of the public.

- 7. ACCESS. Tenant shall have the non-exclusive right of ingress and egress from a public right-of-way, seven (7) days a week, twenty-four (24) hours a day, to and from the Premises for the purpose of installation, operation and maintenance of Tenant's communications equipment over or along a right-of-way ("Easement"), which shall be depicted on Exhibit "B". Tenant may use the Easement for the installation, operation and maintenance of wires, cables, conduits and pipes for all necessary electrical, telephone, fiber and other similar support services. In the event it is necessary, Landlord agrees to grant Tenant or the provider the right to install such services on, through, over and/or under the Premises and any other real property owned by or under the control of Landlord adjacent to the Premises, provided the location of such services shall be reasonably approved by Landlord. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the Premises shall include such additional space sufficient for Tenant's Communication Facility.
- 8. <u>DEFAULT</u>. A default shall occur if either party shall fail to keep and perform any express written provision of this Agreement and such failure continues for a period of thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice, unless such failure cannot be cured within a period of thirty (30) days and, prior to the expiration of thirty (30) days after receipt of notice, the party failing to keep or perform the provision commences to eliminate such failure and proceeds diligently to take steps to cure the same. On the occurrence of default, the non-defaulting party may, without limitation, remedy the default and deduct the cost thereof from subsequent payments to the defaulting party or pursue any available remedies at law or in equity. In no event shall Landlord be entitled to accelerate rent due from Tenant or to take possession of the Premises, the Communications Facility or other personal property owned by Tenant on the Premises. Both parties shall have the duty to use commercially reasonable efforts to mitigate damages in the event of default.
- 9. <u>INTERFERENCE</u>. Tenant shall not use, nor shall Tenant permit the use of any portion of the Premises or the Easement or adjoining or proximate property of Landlord in any way which causes interference, that is measurable in accordance with industry standards, to the then existing equipment of Landlord or with Landlord's Use. Without limiting any other rights or remedies, if interference occurs and continues for a period in excess of twenty-four (24) hours following notice, the Tenant shall be required to reduce power or cease operations of the interfering equipment until the interference is cured. If Tenant violates this Section and the violation continues for twenty-four (24) hours after Landlord has given Tenant oral notice of such violation, Landlord may, beginning on the date of

- the violation, withhold rent payments until such violation is remedied in addition to all other remedies now or hereafter afforded or provided by law and this Agreement.
- 10. <u>TERMINATION</u>. Except as may be otherwise provided in this Agreement, this Agreement may be terminated, without penalty or further liability, immediately upon written notice or otherwise as provided below:
 - a. By Tenant upon thirty (30) days written notice if Tenant is unable to obtain or maintain any license, permit or other Government Approvals necessary to the construction and operation of the Communications Facility or Tenant's Use;
 - b. Immediately by Tenant if the Premises or Communications Facility is damaged so as to, in Tenant's discretion, hinder Tenant's Use;
 - c. By Tenant upon thirty (30) days written notice, in the event that, in Tenant's discretion, interference, whether or not from Landlord's activities or any other source, hinders Tenant's Use and which interference may not, in Tenant's discretion, be adequately corrected or eliminated by Tenant;
 - d. By Tenant at any time for any reason or no reason in Tenant's sole discretion.
 - e. By either party upon a default of any covenant or term of this Agreement by the other party which default is not cured within thirty (30) days of receipt of written notice of default (without, however, limiting any other rights available to the parties pursuant to any other provisions of this Agreement).

11. INDEMNIFICATION.

- a. Subject to §11, and subject to the limitations of South Dakota law with respect to Tenant's authority to indemnify another for any claim, the Tenant and/or any successor and/or assignees thereof, shall indemnify and hold harmless the Landlord, and/or any successors and/or assignees thereof, against any and all claims of liability or loss from personal injury or property damage resulting from or arising out of the negligence or willful misconduct of the Tenant, its employees, contractors or agents, except to the extent such claims or damages may be due to or caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of the Landlord, or its employees, contractors or agents.
- b. Subject to the limitations of South Dakota law with respect to Landlord's authority to indemnify another for any claim, the Landlord and/or any successor and/or assignees thereof, shall indemnify and hold harmless the Tenant, and/or any successors and/or assignees thereof, against any and all claims of liability or loss from personal injury or property damage resulting from or arising out of the negligence or willful misconduct of the Landlord, its employees, contractors or agents, except to the extent such claims or damages may be due to or caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of the Tenant, or its employees, contractors or agents.
- c. All indemnification obligations shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

- 12. <u>INSURANCE</u>. The Tenant agrees that all time it shall maintain commercial general liability insurance providing occurrence form contractual, personal injury, bodily injury and a property damage liability coverage with limits of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 general aggregate, and \$2,000,000 aggregate products and completed operations. The required limit may include excess liability (umbrella) coverage. The policy shall name the Landlord and its representatives as an additional insured and an endorsement will be provided to Landlord. If "occurrence form" insurance is not available, "claims made" insurance will be acceptable.
- 13. <u>REMOVAL AT END OF TERM</u>. No portion of the Communications Facility shall become permanent fixtures upon the land and shall not vest to Landlord's benefit for any reason, except as hereinafter specified. The Communications Facility shall at all times remain the personal property of the Tenant.
- 14. <u>NOTICES</u>. All notices hereunder must be in writing and shall be deemed validly given if sent by email or certified mail, return receipt requested or by commercial courier, provided the courier's regular business is delivery service and provided further that it guarantees delivery to the addressee by the end of the next business day following the courier's receipt from the sender, addressed as follows (or any other address that the Party to be notified may have designated to the sender by like notice):

- 15. <u>REMEDIES</u>. No provision of this Agreement shall limit the rights of a non-defaulting Party in the exercise of any right or remedy which the non-defaulting Party may have by reason of such default under the Laws or judicial decisions of the State of South Dakota.
- APPLICABLE LAWS. During the Term, Landlord shall maintain the Premises in compliance with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, directives, covenants, easements, consent decrees, zoning and land use regulations, and restrictions of record, now in effect or which may hereafter come into effect per South Dakota laws, applicable federal laws and ordinances or laws of Minnehaha County, State of South Dakota (collectively "Laws"). Tenant shall comply with (i) all Laws relating solely to Tenant's specific and unique nature of use of the Premises; and (ii) all building codes requiring modifications to the Premises due to the improvements being made by Tenant in the Premises. It shall be Landlord's obligation to comply with all Laws relating to the Premises, without regard to specific use (including, without limitation, modifications required to enable Tenant to obtain all necessary building permits).

17. MISCELLANEOUS.

a. <u>Entire Agreement</u>. This Agreement contains all agreements, promises and understandings between the Landlord and the Tenant regarding this transaction, and no oral agreement, promises or understandings shall be binding upon either the Landlord or the Tenant in any dispute, controversy or proceeding.

- b. Amendment and Waiver. This Agreement may not be amended or varied except in a writing signed by all Parties. Neither party will be deemed to have waived any of its rights under the Agreement by any statement or representation other than (i) by an Authorized Representative and (ii) in an explicit written waiver. No waiver of a breach of this agreement will constitute a waiver of any prior or subsequent breach of this Agreement.
- c. <u>Severability</u>. Should any section or provision of this Agreement be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same will not affect the validity of the Agreement as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid. If any term of this Agreement is found to be void or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining terms of this Agreement, which shall continue in full force and effect.
- d. <u>Binding Effect</u>. Except as otherwise expressly set forth in this Agreement, this Agreement shall extend to and bind the heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns hereto.
- e. Governing Law/Choice of Forum. The performance of this Agreement shall be governed, interpreted, construed and regulated by the laws of the State of South Dakota without regard to the state's choice of law provision. The parties expressly consent and agree to the exclusive jurisdiction of and venue in the 2nd Judicial Circuit Courts in Minnehaha County, South Dakota, for all purposes in connection with any lawsuit between the parties arising out of or relating to this Agreement.
- f. <u>Marketing/Trademarks</u>. Except as expressly set forth in this Agreement, nothing in this Agreement shall grant, suggest or imply any authority for one Party to use the name, trademarks, service marks or trade names of the other for any purpose whatsoever.
- g. <u>Captions</u>. Articles and paragraph captions are not a part hereof.
- h. <u>Interest On Past-Due Obligations</u>. Except as expressly herein provided, interest shall be charged on any amount due which is more than ten (10) days delinquent at the rate provided by law for past due accounts (SDCL 54-3-5).
- i. <u>Appropriation of Funds</u>. If funds are not budgeted or appropriated for any fiscal year for services to be provided by the terms of this Agreement, this Agreement shall terminate upon thirty (30) days written notice.
- j. Force Majeure. Neither party shall be deemed in default of this Agreement to the extent that performance of its obligations or attempts to cure any breach thereof are delayed or prevented by reason of any act of God, government, fire, natural disaster, accident, terrorism, network or telecommunication system failure, sabotage or any other cause beyond the control of such party ("Force Majeure"), provided that such party promptly gives the other party written notice of such Force Majeure.
- k. <u>Time is of the Essence</u>. Time is of the essence of this Agreement.
